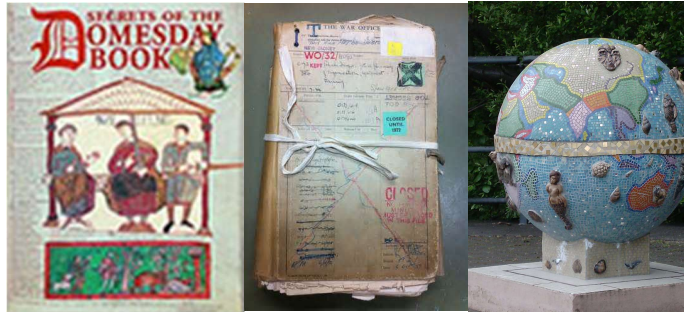


Behind the scenes tour of The National Archives
